Can I switch from a 100% online programme to a conventional programme, and must I do so within a certain timeframe?

Yes, transfers are available and subject to credit transfer requirements. Thus, it is advisable to complete the module you are enrolled in before requesting for transfer.

Is it compulsory to attend the weekly live session?

No, attendance is not compulsory as all live sessions are recorded and made available on the platform. However, it is to your advantage to attend the live session as you will have the opportunity to connect with your lecturers.



How is a programme conducted and how do I know if I am learning effectively? The weekly content you will be required to go through includes bite-sized activities designed to help you check if you have correctly acquired and understood the intended learning. The online activities take a few minutes to complete, and help you progress confidently

from one topic to another.



How are examinations conducted?

Students are assessed through the completion of several assignments. A module commonly includes three assessments that can be completed at home and uploaded on the learning platform by the submission date.
