Students regularly participate in visits to the courts, Attorney General's chambers, prisons and the Parliament, to gain exposure to law in action and to help them gain a deeper insight into the legal practice.

## TAYLOR'S IMPACT LAB STUDENT ACTIVITIES

Taylor's law students engage in community presentations, where they share their legal expertise with diverse audiences, actively contributing to the betterment of the community.







## COMMUNITY OUTREACH

We encourage our students to actively contribute their time and effort to the community's needs and participate in community service activities, such as fundraising, visits to charitable organisations and also offer pro bono legal advice. These activities shape individuals who excel as legal professionals but remain sensitive towards the community's needs and rights.

## **MLE Project: Fake News Detection Among Law, Computing and Business Students in Times of COVID-19**

This project has provided insights to understanding and ascertaining the nature and severity of COVID-19 false news and efficacy of the Government's counter measures in addressing this issue. It assisted in enhancing the development of false news verification on social media with regards to legal rules and news related to COVID-19 as well as its application in industrial settings using crowdsourcing.



## **MLE Project: Company Law Legal Literacy and Advice Consultation for Business Start-Ups for Young Entrepreneurs**

This project provided opportunities for law students to furnish legal information and advice to prospective young entrepreneurs in the business school during their business start-up phase.

The collaboration provided an opportunity for the young entrepreneurs to enhance their legal knowledge in the setting up of business entities. It also helped the young entrepreneurs familiarise themselves with important legal rules and regulations. The project enables the reduction of legal risks and increases the exchange of experience between the legal and entrepreneurship spheres.

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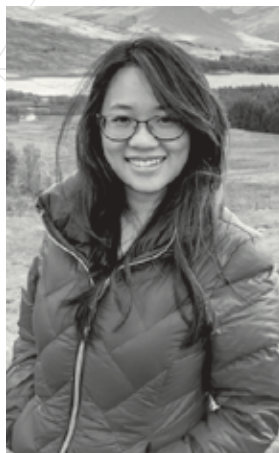

## SUMMER COURSE ON THE MALAYSIAN LEGAL SYSTEM

The Summer Course on the Malaysian Legal System provides an avenue for foreign students to observe and understand the Malaysian legal system, which also includes an internship placement at a local legal firm. This exchange programme provides a unique opportunity for our students to engage in international discourse with their peers from various parts of the world and gain better understanding of the legal systems and practices in different countries.

## TAYLOR'S LEGAL AID CENTRE

The centre was officially launched in collaboration with the Malaysian Bar Council in March 2011 as a community service project to provide pro bono legal advice to the Taylor's Community (i.e. students and staff) and also to residents around Subang and Sunway.

The aim of the centre is to provide clinical legal education to our students as well as opportunities for research and networking. The areas of law that the centre handles are Family, Landlord and Tenant, Employment, Finance and Consumer-related matters.

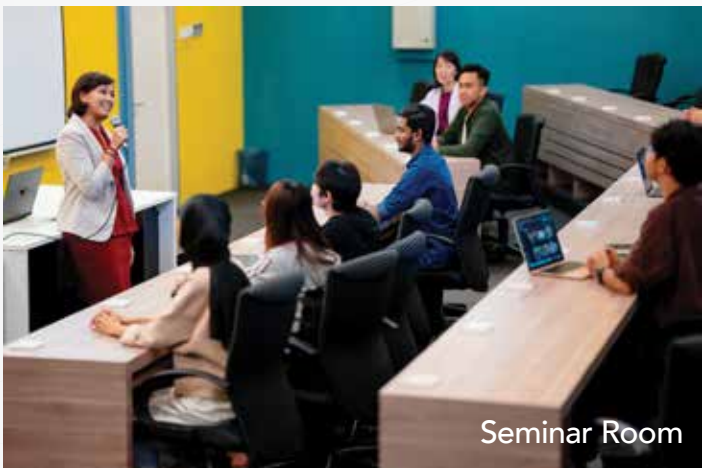

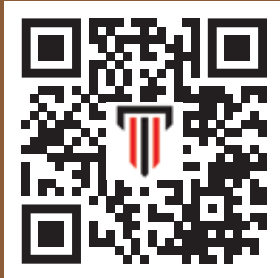

The programme provides a platform for students to undertake independent research in various areas of law like Corporate Laws, International Business and Trade-related Laws, Healthcare and Medical Laws as well as Human Rights and Liberties, just to name a few. Graduates of this programme will be sought-after for their ability to conduct in-depth research and contribute towards the development of the legal field.

**PhD by Prior Publication is a pathway to achieve a Doctoral award. The candidate's publications before registration are included in the submission for the Doctoral award.**

### DURATION

Full time

6 months – 2 years

## Entry Requirements:

- i) Candidates must obtain a master's degree in the field or related fields accepted by the HEP Senate; or
- ii) Other qualifications equivalent to a master's degree recognised by the Government of Malaysia; or
- iii) Candidates without a related qualification in the field/s or working experience in the relevant fields must undergo appropriate prerequisite courses determined by the HEP;

In addition to the above criteria, those who want to join Doctoral Degree by Retrospective or Prior Publication mode must include the below to their formal application:

- i) minimum of 5 publications or equivalent works in alignment with the theme of the specialisation;
- ii) an executive summary of the above publications to demonstrate the applicant's contribution to knowledge in the field; and
- iii) a list of scholarly published work; AND

A Selection Committee must be established to review the formal application for PhD by Retrospective or Prior Publication and recommend to the Senate to obtain approval;

AND

The minimum language proficiency of the candidates must be determined by the HEP consistent with applicable programme standards or based on the needs of the programme, i.e., learning outcomes and the medium of instruction.

### \* Criteria for published works

- a) Published work must encompass high-quality journals, monographs, books, research-based chapters in books, electronic publications, creative works and artefacts in the field which have not been used to obtain other awards or deemed a part of those awards.
- b) The publications or productions must be published or produced within a period not exceeding ten (10) years from the date of submission.
- c) For the five (5) nominated publications or productions, the candidate must be the principal author or creator with the contributions of others clearly defined.
